On looking up our ledgers we find that the forty shares representing \$40,000 par value have been increased by a stock dividend of \$1,428.56 making the total standing to your credit in the stock of the Proctor and Gamble Company \$41,428.56. We also have on our ledgers an entry of \$160. for dividends up to August 15th, 1923. Apparently dividends are paid but once a year and that at the rate of 4%. Does this give you all the information you want?
