I have your letter of Oct. 31st making application for the establishment of an organized mission in Barrio Caimito, Rio Piedras in accordance with the Section 1 of Canon 26 of the Missionary District of Porto Rico.

I find your application in order and signed by thirty-three members of the congregation. I take it that these signatures are all approved by you.

You are hereby notified, therefore, that, in accordance with Canon 26 the mission of St. Joseph in Barrio Caimito, Rio Piedras is hereby established as an "organized mission" of this district and that in accordance with Article 4 of the Constitution it will have the privilege of sending two lay delegates to the next and all succeeding annual convocations of the district.
