

St. Stephen's Episcopal Church consecrated

St. Stephen's Episcopal Church's new home was officially consecrated recently. The parish was established in 1961 to provide services in English for persons living in the Rio Piedras-Guaynabo area. Work on the new building began in January 1977 and it was occupied last October. It is located on Logal Street in Urb. San Amón. The priest in charge of St. Stephen's is the Rev. A. Wade Eaton, Jr. New members are being sought. At present there are approximately 17 families as permanent members of the church.

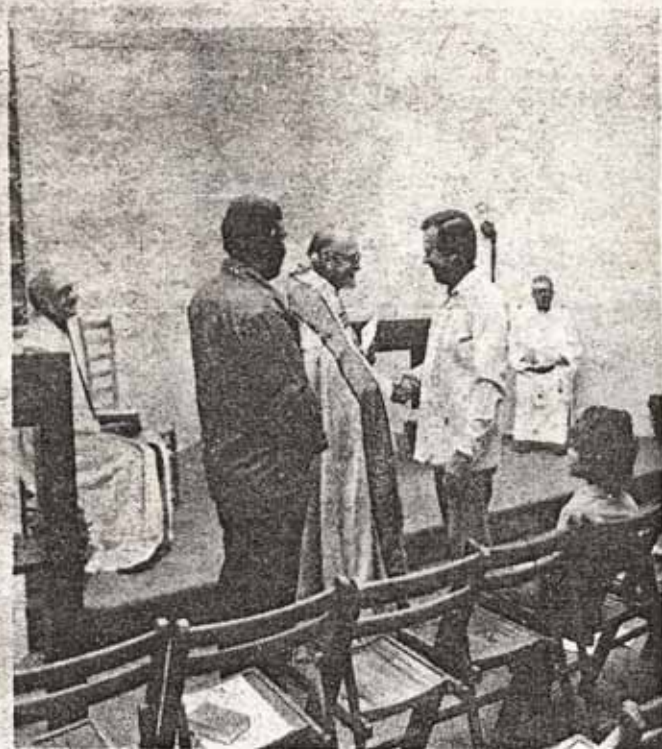
